Vinification

The grapes were harvested manually in the early hours of the day, to 12kg boxes.

After selection and sorting of the perfect grapes, they were destemmed and gently crushed.

The fermentation and later stage of 9 months were in French oak barrels, with the presence of fine lees.

Tasting Notes

The Malhadinha White 2018 Edition comes with a fresh and complex nose, with hints of white fruits and the barrel in the background. In the mouth, the same feeling of freshness and balance in an elegant set with a long and very persistent finish.
