Vinification

Grapes grown in our estate were hand harvested in 12Kg small boxes and sorted before being destemmed and slightly crushed. Monte da Peceguina Rosé is the result of direct pressings and selected bleedings on our top red musts. The bleed is made after a couple of hours of cold soak. The wine fermented is stainless steel vats at low temperatures for 3 weeks.

Tasting Notes

Soft salmon colored. Peceguina Rosé 2013 shows a fresh aroma dominated by notes of red fruits. On the palate is light and balanced but complex. Good companion for light meals.
