Grapes were hand picked into 12 Kg boxes and selected at the sorting table. Fermentation occurred in stainless steel lagares with temperature control and traditional maceration. Aged for 14 months in new French oak barrels.

**Tasting Notes**  
The 2013 edition of Malhadinha Red reveals great a complex bouquet of aromas of dark and red ripe fruits, spices, graphite, high quality barrel notes refresh by a balsamic background. The palate is bold and round, showing good structure supported by silky tannins and a lively freshness. Long finish. Great aging potential.
