#### Vinification

Grapes were hand picked into 12 Kg boxes and selected at the sorting table. Fermentation occurred in stainless steel lagares with temperature control and traditional maceration. Aged for 14 months in new French oak barrels.

## **Tasting Notes**

Vibrant red color with purple hints. Great aromatic complexity, lots of ripe red and black fruits, floral, spicy and toasty notes with a mineral background. In the palate the fruit is pure and focused, good body with silky tannins. A Malhadinha with great character and ageing potential.
