Grapes were hand picked into 12 Kg boxes and selected at the sorting table. Fermentation occurred in stainless steel lagares with temperature control and traditional maceration and also in tronco-conic vats. Partially aged for 9 months in French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

Bouquet overwhelmed by ripe gruit, suculent, full of energy and freshness. Beautiful complexity with floral envelopment, slight wooden cosiness that is smoothened by a very well structered body and deeply marked by spices and vegetable notes.
