Winemaking

The grapes were grown in our vineyard and picked by hand, carried in small boxes of 12kgs to the winery and sorted before destemming and lightly crushing. Open-fermentation process occurred with controlled temperatures and lasted 12 days in small open fermenters. The wine aged in french barrels (225 Lts) for 12 months.

Winemaker's notes

Very deep and concentrated colour
The aromas are complex with a very
elegant presence of the cabernet sauvignon
and some spicy notes.
The palate is intense and concentrated with
very elegant tanins, but very full.
Big with a long finish showing some cofee
notes on the end.
