Vinification

Grapes harvested to 12 kg boxes and carefully selected at the choosing table. Fermentation ocurred at the mill with controlled temperature with many pressings throughout the whole process. 12 months staging in new french oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

The new edition of Pequeno João is once again a 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, still very young on the aroma, of a pure red colour that reveals for now a very complex bouquet of ripe blue and blackberries, hints of spices and great hood. On the mouth it's a little diamond still to perfect, with vigorous but tamed tanins, keeping The fruity but serious profile, finishes quite long.
